## Project Based Learning – Grade 3

Project based learning is an integral part of learning at Whitefield Global School. Each year students take up a Sustainable Development Goal and engage in activities and complete a project to learn more about the goal and resolution to the challenges faced.

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), also known as the Global Goals, were adopted by the United Nations in 2015 as a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure that by 2030 all people enjoy peace and prosperity. The 17 SDGs are integrated—they recognize that action in one area will affect outcomes in others, and that development must balance social, economic and environmental sustainability.











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At Whitefield Global School students of Grade 3 were empowered to learn about SDG # 7- 'Affordable and Clean Energy' during their Project Based Learning (PBL). The philosophy of Project Based Learning (PBL) approach is to help children become strong thinkers, learners, and doers. Studies have showed that in the long run it improves knowledge retention, improves problem solving and collaboration skills and brings in a great attitude towards learning. It was a 2-week learning process involving various activities and projects in all the subjects in integrated mode aimed at making students think more about SDG #7. The students created black hole models, solar ovens, pinwheels and did comparative studies of countries on how they are using renewable resources. The event culminated with a final presentation by Students on all their learnings and awareness about the importance of Affordable and Clean Energy for future.
