Students enjoyed the assembly and were able to realize the importance of collaboration in their lives for future leadership roles. The assembly was concluded with the National Anthem.










ACTIVITIES OF STUDENTS

Learning by doing activities is a fun approach since it boosts the development of the brain in children by providing them with constant stimulus to respond. Our students have been learning new concepts in different subjects through different activities. Activity-based learning is achieved mainly in three ways which are, experimentation, expression, and exploration.

This was put into practice in grade II English class where they enhanced their presentation skills through a roleplay activity on the contribution of everyday helpers in our lives. In EVS, they learned about the properties of air. They also learned the different features of MS Paint and beautifully presented their artwork during the computer classes.

Grade 3 students drew a big pizza and cut it into many slices and used different combinations of it to learn Fractions in Math. They learned how to draw colourful circles with different colours and pen sizes using different blocks in Scratch. In Grade 4 Science, students marked the most important Wind, Solar, and Thermal Power Sites on Map. As part of Math activity, they also measured the length, breadth, and height of different objects at home using measuring tape/ruler, and then they converted their findings into the lowest unit. In Grade 5 Social Studies a skit was performed by young actors on the struggle for independence -Bengal Partition and Swadeshi Movement, etc. We're very proud of the dedication of our students.






SPELLBEE STATE LEVEL EXAMINATION
